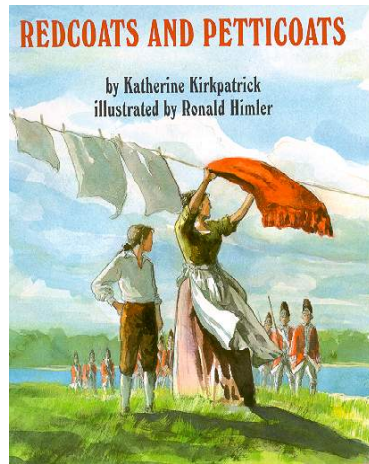


Spies!

How the Culper Spy Ring fooled the British to gather and send messages to General Washington

A Three Village Historical Society In-School Presentation for Students



- Students **decode** signals sent with Anna Smith Strong's laundry line.
- Students **map** the hiding places of Caleb Brewster's whaleboat.
- Students **role play** being members of the Culper Spy Ring.
- Students **make** invisible ink and **write** with quill pens.
- Students **develop** a secret code and **use** it to write each other messages
- Students **read and decode** letters from George Washington's patriot spy ring.

Presentations range in length from 40 minutes to one hour, depending upon the needs of the teacher. Our educators move from classroom to classroom with all equipment and supplies, teaching groups of 25-30 students in each. Fees are \$200 for the first class, and \$100 for each additional class, with a maximum of four classes per day.
